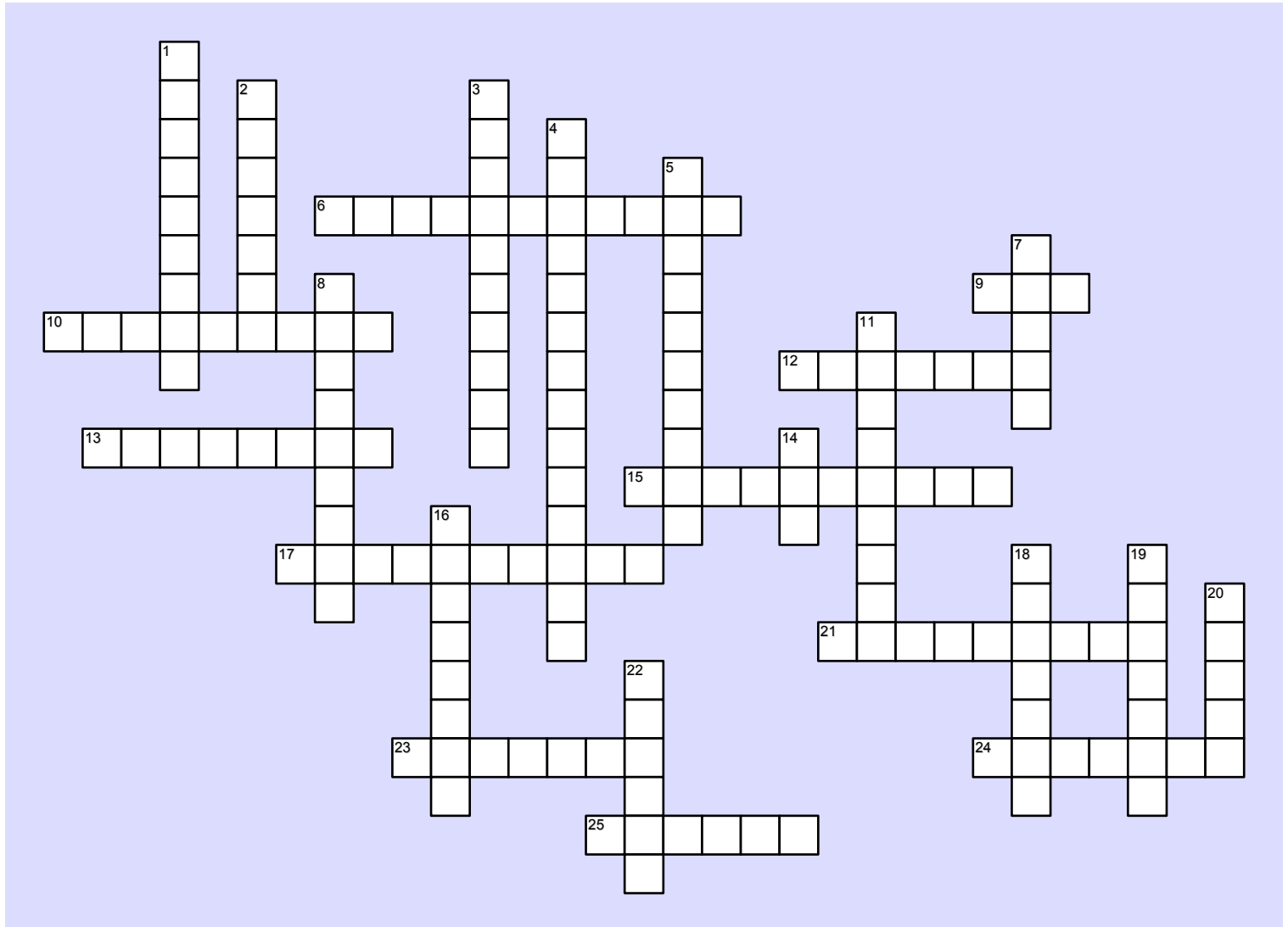

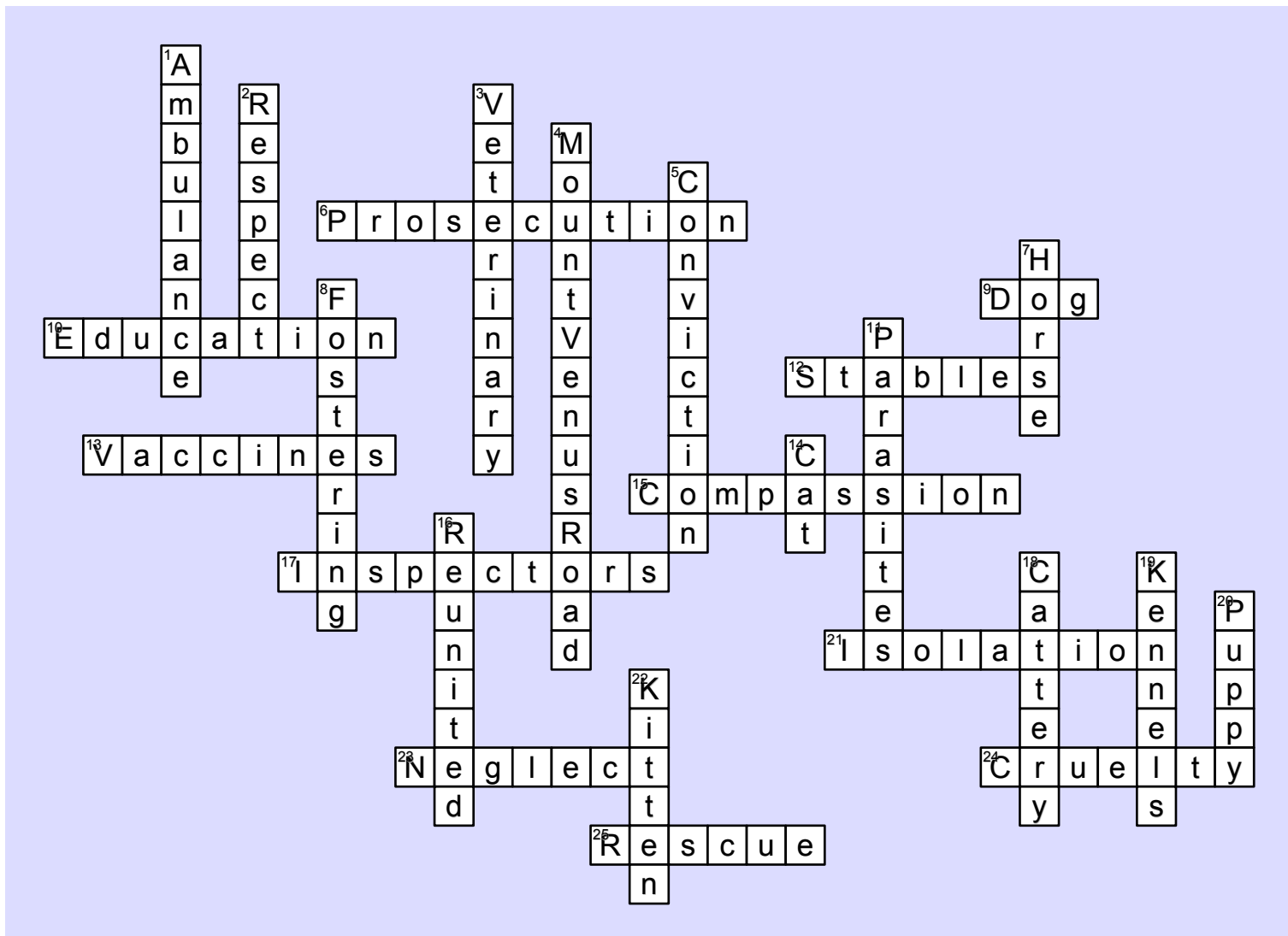
- 15: Sympathy for the sufferings or trouble of another or others.
